

Ordinance No. 96.

Ordinance for a tax levy on all real and personal property within the corporate limits of the City of Wathena, Kansas for the year 1924.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena, Kansas:

Sec. 1. That a levy of three mills for general purposes, three mills for grading, culverts and cross walks one mill for fire department, one mill for street lighting, one mill for interest and sinking fund and $\frac{1}{2}$ mill for Park contingent be hereby assessed against all real and personal property within the corporate limits of the City of Wathena, Kansas for the year 1924.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force on and after its publication in The Kansas Chief.
