## Ordinance No. 97

An Ordinance Regulating The Keeping of Swine Within the City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas.

Be it Ordained By the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas.

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to keep swine in the city limits of Wathena at any time of the year, without first having secured a permit so to do from the Mayor and Council. Application for such permit must be made in writing by the owner of said swine, stating the lot and block on which swine are proposed to be kept and such permit must obligate the applicant to keep and maintain his premises so used that the same will not be unclean or unhealthy. In no event shall swine or hog pens be maintained within 150 feet of any occupied dwelling. Such permits shall not be for a longer time than six months and may be revoked at any time by the Mayor and Council. Such permits shall be issued by the CityiClerk on order of the Mayor and Council and the applicant shall pay a fee of fifty cents (50¢) for issuing of such a permit.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall atke effect and be in full force from and after its publication once in the Doniphan County News.
