

Ordinance No. 98

An Ordinance Passing on a Petition for Paving, Curbing, Guttering and Grading Certain Streets and Providing for Said Improvements.

Whereas; There has been heretofore filed with the Mayor and Council of the City of Wathena, Kansas, a petition for the grading, paving, curbing guttering and otherwise improving certain streets in the city of Wathena, Kansas, described as Beginning on Doniphan street from the North side of Fremont Street to the North side of Jesse street, and extending on Jesse Street, from East side of Doniphan street to East side of Moss street, and estending on Bryan street from the North side of Jesse street to the North side of Benton street, and; Whereas, The said Mayor and Council have considered said petition, the names thereon and the resident owners of property abutting on said improvements and liable for the costs thereof and finding that more than a majority of the resident owners of said real property liable for taxation for said improvements has signed said petition and that said improvements should be made.

Therefore, Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Wathena, Kansas, Section 1, that in accordance with the said petition the said improvements be made on the above named streets as above set out and in accordance with the plans and specifications of the City engineer, on file with the city clerk That the credit of the city is hereby pledged for the payment of the costs of said improvement and that special assessments shall be levied on the property liable for such parts of said improvement as is provided for by law.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage by the council, its approval by the Mayor and its publication once in the Doniphan County News.
