A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS, ENDORSING KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, AS THE CHOICE FOR THE LOCATION OF THE MCDONNELL DOUGLAS MD-12 PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Douglas Aircraft Company, the commercial division of McDonnell Douglas, is seeking a site to construct a new manufacturing facility for its MD-12 aircraft and is considering Kansas City, Missouri, as a possible location for the new facility; and,


