RESOLUTION NO. 97 - 4

RELATING TO AN ALLEGED DANGEROUS STRUCTURE AT THE INTERSECTION OF ST. JOSEPH AND FIRST STREETS, WATHENA, KANSAS, FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR A HEARING TO DETERMINE WHETHER SUCH STRUCTURE SHOULD BE CONDEMNED, AND PROVIDING FOR THE SERVICE OF NOTICE OF SUCH HEARING.

WHEREAS, the Enforcing Officer under Ordinance No. 428 of the City of Wathena, Kansas, has filed a complaint with the Governing Body of said City alleging that a certain structure located at the intersection of St. Joseph and First Streets in the City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas, upon real estate legally described as:

Lot 12, in Block 20, in the Original Town, now City of Wathena, Doniphan County, Kansas,

is dangerous and unsafe and should be condemned and ordered demolished:

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WATHENA, KANSAS:

1. A hearing before the Governing Body of the City of Wathena, Kansas, is hereby ordered to be held on the aforesaid complaint on the 7th day of October, 1997, at 8:30 o'clock P.M. at the City Hall in Wathena, Kansas.
